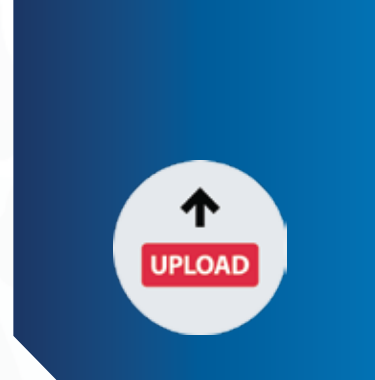

Extended Abstract

■ First Page:

Title, Track, Abstract (250–300 words), and Keywords

■ Second Page Onwards:

- Introduction
- Research objective
- Methodology
- Findings
- Implications
- Limitations and future research directions

■ Last Page: References

Prepare and submit an extended abstract (2000–2500 words, excluding references, tables, and figures) in Microsoft Word. Submissions exceeding 2500 words will not be reviewed. Include a 300–word abstract on the first page that outlines the importance, methodology, conclusion, and implications of your research. Up to four keywords can be provided. The first page must contain the title, abstract, and keywords. Paper content begins on the second page, with the last page reserved for references. Copyrighted material should be identified, and explicit permission for reproduction must be submitted separately to the Doctoral Colloquium email. No changes to the title, abstract, or authorship are allowed after submission.

■ Note:

It is mandatory to mention “International Doctoral Colloquium 2025” on top of the submission – be it extended abstract or abstract in order to be considered for the Doctoral Colloquium 2025. Also, the submission file name should be kept as IDC2025.

■ Review Criteria

- **Research Relevance & Originality** – Focus on contemporary issues, innovative approach, and contribution to the field.
- **Academic Rigor** – Sound theoretical foundation, clarity in research objectives, and appropriate methodology.
- **Presentation & Structure** – Logical flow, clear articulation of research problem, objectives, findings, and conclusions.
- **Clarity of Problem Definition** – Well-defined research question or hypothesis, with clear scope and direction.
- **Scholarly Writing Quality** – Clarity of expression, coherence, referencing accuracy, and adherence to academic standards.
