The Business Analytics Laboratory in KLH Global Business School is equipped with High-end configuration systems and essential software installed which includes SPSS, Power-BI, and R-Programming. SPSS (Statistical Package for the Social Sciences) is a software used for data analysis for descriptive and bivariate statistics, numerical result forecasts, and predictions for group identification. Additionally, the program offers graphing, direct marketing, and data processing functions. In its main view, the software interface shows open data in a manner akin to a spreadsheet. 



Book review of "The Kite Runner"



The kite runner tells the story of a young boy, Amir, coming from an opulent family residing in Kabul, Afghanistan, in the 1970's. The family lives a luxurious life, ranging from a bungalow filled with servants to supreme cars. The story encircles the adventures and beautiful moments of friendship that Amir shares with his closest friend, Hassan, the housekeeper's son. However, after a certain unfortunate event aspires for Hassan at the kite festival, it turns out to be the pivotal moment that changes his life forever, forcing him and his father to leave Kabul. Cut to 10 years later, the story revolves around Amir, who now has it all with a peaceful life in California. He then receives a call in 2001, in which he is told that he has to save a little boy who is now in the hands of the vicious and brutal Taliban. Amir then sets out an endeavour to Kabul to save him, where he unravels uncomfortable truths upon revealing the identity of this little boy.
